Minutes

1. Introduction and Attendance

2. Approval of Previous Minutes

3. Correspondence In/Out

All correspondence is being covered in major points of the meeting, with the exception of one student asking about involvement in the winter staffing season. This was received after Swinburne TCSE and Youth ANZAAS, and so he was instead directed to MYSci and socials.

4. Committee Member Reports

President: Handover to Jess is progressing, should be done soon. August is looking a lot quieter since we don't have National Science Week, but September is abnormally busy. All else will be discussed later in the meeting.

VP-Sci: Handover is going well, also attended NatCon and e-mails.

VP-Socials: Survived another month.

Treasurer: Had the financial report done in time for the SGM. All the reconciling is done, the financial tracking should be up and running again soon.

Secretary: I have recently started using Tidy to distribute tasks, people have enjoyed doing this, so I will look into using this more as people seem to enjoy it.

Communications: Pretty quiet this month - we've gotten the e-mail out about the breach, no response yet. Last month was our highest rate of attraction on Facebook, probably due to Youth ANZAAS, Swinburne TCSE, and science in the park.

Aemilia: Gonna have to start delegating design work because there's too much, also need photos to do the design work.

Josh: Changed the dates for MYSci, as well as writing the MYSci page for our website.

Jaimee: Researched LIDO for October social, looks okay, but probably only worth booking seats, not a theatre. Otherwise, look at the legalities of doing it ourselves in a lecture theatre with Netflix.

IPP: Not too much to report, wasn't here at the last meeting, but have assisted with ANZAAS. Soon I will be liasing with Jess for the November social.

5. NatCon Summary

NatCon happened, was in Sydney, had all four current presidents at. It was very productive, most of which happened on the sides. Some of the material from NatCon will be moving to a Skype call following this meeting. As a general overview, Sydney are doing okay in TCSEs but struggling with socials, Brisbane is the converse. We still need to obtain the other chapter reports, which we will then circulate with our committee. All states have also agreed to endorse interstate exchange as well, which we'll discuss in more detail soon.

Sydney have asked for help with socials, so we would like a GeM to go through their inbox, and write a summary of our social resources (what we did, comments on how we went, and media releases) to share with Sydney to help them with running socials.

We are in charge of NatCon next year, hopefully it will run well and we can get everyone there.

We also discussed insurance at NatCon, it was brought up that Jackie from the SSF might be able to get us public liability insurance through the SSF's insurer, which may cut our insurance costs as it will be joint with all chapters.

14. New GeM Appointment

As we have so many applicants, it is worth deciding to co-opt some of the applicants as unofficial committee members. As per our constitution, only one of them can be an official GeM, so we need to decide a few things - one, who will be the official GeM, two, how many others we want to co-opt. This will be a four point process:

1. How many GeMs we wish to take on.

It was suggested by Michael that we only take 3 to make quorum easier to manage, James suggested 4 so that we can get more people involved. Maxine made the point that we do not need to co-opt people to get them involved. This was done to a vote, in which we decided on 3, with a favour of 5 versus 3.

2. Have a discussion of each GeM, and note any issues or major benefit we'd get from them joining us.

The first is Bec, it was noted that she's helped before, and is a valued member. She was interested in March, but was unsure having only just starting to uni, but now must be sure. Bec has also helped out with instagram.

The second is Becky Smith, it was noted she's very enthusiastic, and is also a younger member. We'd have less availability from her during school time, and has been to nearly ever social. Becky has also helped out with instagram, she was also a pretty good staffie, no issues.

The third is Lauren Robertson, Lauren has helped us before with some last-minute assistance, she's really good at alleviating stress. She's helped us with planning socials, and a lot with Youth ANZAAS.

The fourth is Lily Xia, she'd be a really good candidate. She's been with us for a while, but

she's not been very active. She has a lot of useful contacts, and has helped us out of a lot of jams. She has all the skills we like in admin tasks, but isn't as socially involved as Lily.

The fifth is Annabelle Wang, she's now done two TCSEs with us. She's relatively now, still in school, but over 18. She has a lot of initiative and is very proactive.

The sixth is Jasmine Francis, she'd be a great committee member. It was noted that she's going to turn 26 soon, and would be best utilised as helping us with staffing. She likely won't get much from us on the committee, either.

The seventh is Orion Zymaris, and has been around for about 3 or 4 years now. He has not been very involved until last year, but has been a regular at socials.

3. Select the amount of GeMs as decided in point 1.

After an election process, the decided GeMs are Becky, Bec, and Lauren. They will be notified by the secretary of their success, and those who were not chosen will also be messaged by the secretary, with a list of other opportunities we would like them to help with. We will also notify them if we have committee tasks that we still need help with.

4. Decide on the official GeM of those selected in point 3.

First, we need to decide what rights the co-opted GeMs have. This includes e-mails, Tidy access level, no for any option in circular resolutions, Slack access, treated like a committee member in public and at events, and will definitely be allowed to list themselves as a full GeM in media platforms. Co-opted members will not count for quorum or be able to use this time to run for top 6, as the constitution requires.

It was important to note that if Lauren is given the official role, she could run for top 6. The others won't, as the term is not long enough. It was also noted that Bec will be able to count for a lot of quorum, Becky slightly less so, and Lauren less than that.

Bec Neville was appointed the official GeM.
