#### 6. Socials- online study session

Becky:

-Looking into opening new channel on discord for studying together, since a lot of people are doing VCE science and maths methods

-Voice chat for studying together and text chat for questions, can ask older members and other members studying same subjects for help

Orion:

#### Jamieson:

-In some discord servers for uni, can get roles for different subjects

-If different older members have different roles showing their expertise, people can know who to ask for help and talk with!

#### Wren:

-Ask about different subjects in RSVP form and that's how we'll know what different channels people would like to have

-Bec will figure out how to do this

-It's not currently school holdidays so we can have it in the next few weeks and it'll be during school term - make it the August Social

-Satuday vs Sunday: which is better?

#### Becky:

#### Bec:
